

# DIY Bird Seed Suet

## Ingredients:

Binding agents such as; peanut butter, Crisco, coconut oil, lard, bacon grease etc.-  
¼ to ½ cup of each-dependent upon your final container size.

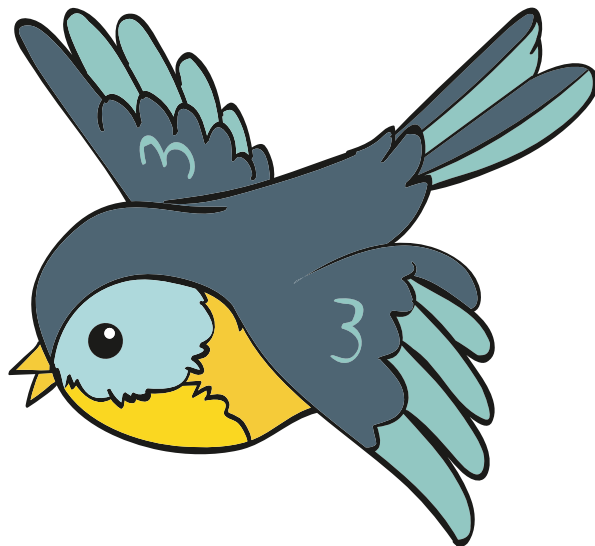
Dry ingredients such as; peanuts, oats, dried fruit, vegetable or fruit scraps

## Utensils:

Measuring cup, spatula, recycled plastic container, saucepan, burner

## Instructions:

1. Crush peanuts and other “chunky” ingredients in a baggie with a mallet.
2. Melt the binding ingredients stirring until smooth.
3. Combine any of the dry ingredients and scraps into the melted binder.
4. Place in the recycled container for 1-2 hours in the freezer,
5. Hang outside for the birds to enjoy.
